2022 Golf Outing Hole Sponsorship

This is the 6th year of our golf outing hole sponsorship with all the proceeds going to the Jennifer Harrison Memorial Scholarship Fund, established in her honor here at Little Flower School. This fund provides in-house tuition scholarships to students currently enrolled at LFS. It is certainly a fitting tribute to Jennifer, who did everything in her power to promote this school. Jennifer's daughter, Ella, graduated from Little Flower in 2020 and is currently going to SHG, and Jennifer's husband, Jim, continues to volunteer and promote the school and parish in many ways.

Three \$1,000 scholarships are given to returning Little Flower students each year. Families must submit completed applications along with an essay to be considered for the scholarship. The committee will review each application and determine who will receive the scholarship for the given year.

The date of this year's Golf Outing is Friday, July 8, and the sponsorship fee is \$150.00 per hole. Your donation will make a positive difference here at Little Flower and will keep the Scholarship Fund thriving for many years. We started this meaningful endeavor in 2016 and thru 2021 we have raised \$23,750. Due to the Covid-19 pandemic in 2020, we did not ask for hole sponsorships.
